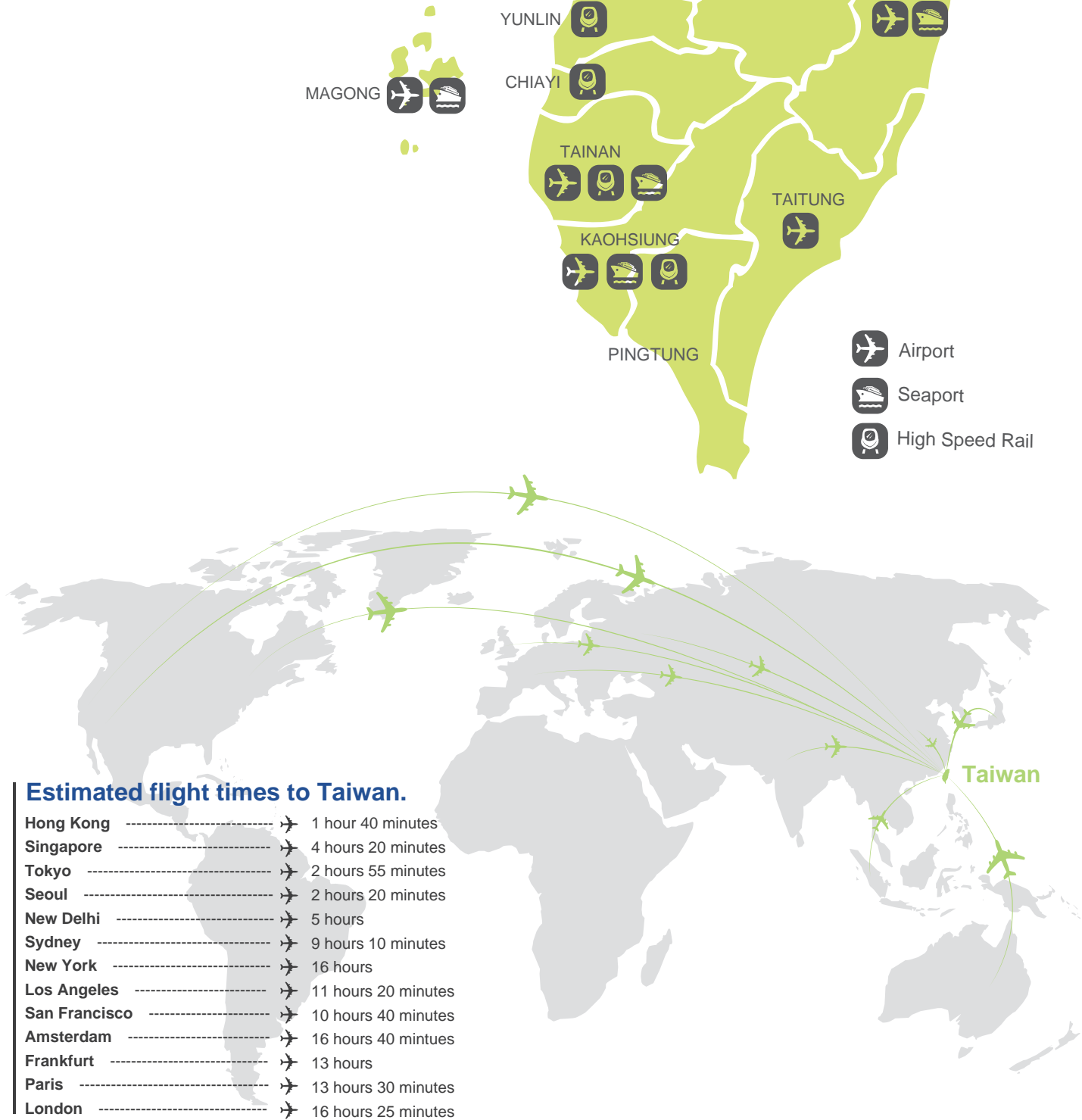
# Transportations

## Easy Access

### By Air

Taiwan has five main international airports with international scheduled flights: Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport, Kaohsiung International Airport, Taipei Songshan Airport, Taichung Airport and Tainan Airport.

Each offers convenient direct links to major countries.



# Getting around Taiwan

## By Domestic Flights

Taiwan's domestic air network provides flights to link 17 airports, serving major centres like Taichung, Tainan, Hualien and Taitung, as well as off-island territories such as Kinmen, Matsu, Penghu, Green Island and Orchid Island.

## By Train



### Taiwan High Speed Rail

Taiwan has an extensive and efficient transport infrastructure, making travel around the island and its cities convenient and stress free. The Taiwan High Speed Rail (THSR) covers 345 kilometres along the west side of the island, whisking passengers from Taipei in the north to Kaohsiung in the south in just 90 minutes.

### Mainline Rail Network

Taiwan also has an established and extensive mainline rail network providing an inexpensive means of getting around the island. The network has stations conveniently located in the centre of cities and towns.



## By Metro System (MRT)

The municipalities of Taipei and Kaohsiung have metro systems called the MRT, providing very cheap and convenient transport. They are rated as some of the best in the world with unparalleled levels of punctuality, reliability and cleanliness.

## By Bus, Car and Taxi

Twenty-four-hour bus services for long distance trips are provided by most bus companies, while overseas visitors can easily hire a car with an international driving licence. Taiwan also offers an abundance of cheap, safe and reliable taxis.



## By Two Wheels

Taiwan has an island-wide cycling route network totaling around 1,000km, inviting visitors to explore endless rolling fun on two wheels. In addition, Taipei, Kaohsiung and many other cities have developed public-use bicycle systems that visitors can conveniently utilize during their stay to access tourist attractions, minimizing carbon emissions and leaving only eco-friendly footprints.





# Time for Nature

At first sight of the island's crystalline lakes and lush gorges, it's abundantly clear why Portuguese explorers called Taiwan 'Formosa', or 'beautiful island'. Two-thirds cloaked by verdant mountains, its eight national parks offer a stunningly diverse landscape to explore, from climbable cliffs and volcanic craters to white-sand coral beaches and tropical forests. On land or on water, it's time to discover one of nature's least-known playgrounds: Taiwan.

Taiwan has been abundantly endowed with mountains; 258 of its peaks are more than 3,000 meters high, making the island geographically unique. As mountains can be found anywhere, mountain climbing is a popular leisure activity in Taiwan. The mountains on the outskirts of the city can be reached within a short time, and they can be easily used for team-building activities. In addition, there are 8 national parks and 13 national scenic areas which offer a variety of distinct topographic landscapes. These natural attractions await your discovery in Taiwan.

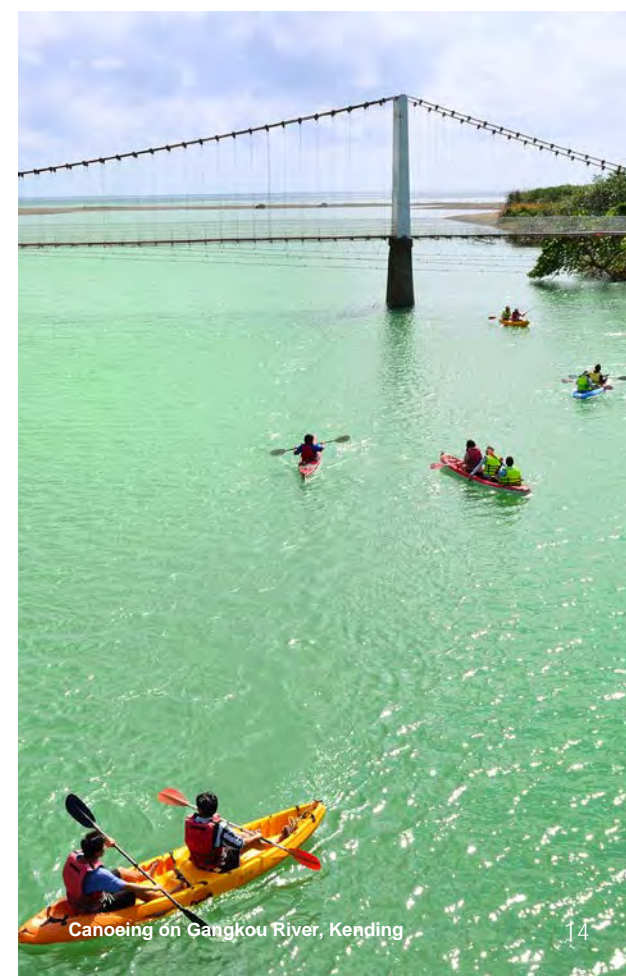

### Day 3

Feel your surroundings

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>In the morning, visit Dharma Drum Mountain (DDM), where you can find spiritual tranquillity through active meditation and by immersing yourself in beautiful environment.</li><li>Onward to Yehliu Geopark, noted for its fantastic rock formations fashioned by the elements through the ages. A famous landmark of the park is the rock formation called the Queen's Head, which reminds many visitors of representations of the ancient Egyptian Queen Nefertiti.</li></ul>

Noon
Head to Beitou, one of the most highly-rated hot-spring areas in Taiwan. Enjoy Kaiseki cuisine at Beitou Museum, built in 1921 during the Japanese colonial era. Now a Taipei historic site, the Japanese-style, two-floor wooden structure offers a fantastic dining experience with its elegant landscaped courtyard. ### ▶ The Red House

# Government Support

## Incentive for the Promotion of Foreign Incentive Tours to Taiwan

**Who is eligible:**

- (1) Foreign incentive tour groups visiting Taiwan and staying for at least 3days/2 nights. Each group should have at least 50 people.
- (2) Businesses or corporate bodies that organize incentive tours and are registered with the competent authorities overseas.
- (3) Foreign tourism destination management companies and travel operators or domestic travel operators commissioned by foreign enterprises or corporate bodies to organize incentive tourism activities in Taiwan.

**Incentive types and principles:**

Types	Details
Bidding phase	<b>Eligible personnel:</b> Foreign personnel with decision-making authority regarding incentive tours to Taiwan. The planned incentive tour group should consists of at least 500 people and each group is limited to one preliminary survey or inspection trip by up to two people.
	<b>Subsidies:</b> Economy-class air fare and standard hotel rooms for personnel visiting Taiwan for preliminary survey or inspection. The subsidy for each hotel room shall not exceed NT\$5,000 per night. The cap for this subsidy item is NT\$200,000.  <b>Application deadline:</b> At least 15 days before the foreign person is to arrive in Taiwan for the on-site survey.
Hosting Phase	<b>A. Staying at least 3 days and 2 nights</b> For groups of 50 ~ 99 people, a subsidy of NT\$20,000 per group is provided. For groups of 100 ~ 200 people, a subsidy of NT\$30,000 per group is provided. For groups of 201 ~ 300 people, a subsidy of NT\$60,000 per group is provided. For groups of 301 ~ 400 people, a subsidy of NT\$80,000 per group is provided. For groups of 401 or more people, a subsidy of NT\$120,000 per group is provided.
	<b>B. Staying at least 4 days and 3 nights</b> For groups of 50 ~ 300 people, a subsidy of NT\$400 per traveler is provided. For groups of 301 ~ 1,000 people, a subsidy of NT\$600 per traveler is provided. For groups of 1,001 or more people, a subsidy of NT\$800 per traveler is provided.  <b>C. An enterprise or corporate body that organizes incentive tours to Taiwan for two consecutive years</b> For groups of 50 ~ 300 people, a subsidy of NT\$600 per traveler is provided. For groups of 301 ~ 1,000 people, a subsidy of NT\$800 per traveler is provided. For groups of 1,001 or more, a subsidy of NT\$1,000 per traveler is provided.  <b>D. Staying at least 4 days and 3 nights, and the groups are from Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, the Philippines, Indonesia, Brunei, Vietnam, Laos, Myanmar, Cambodia, India, Bhutan, Australia, and New Zealand with additional subsidies</b> For groups of 50 ~ 199 people, a subsidy of NT\$400 per traveler is provided and will be used to organize a welcome dinner for the group on the day of its arrival in Taiwan, or the following day. For groups of 200 people or more, in addition to the welcome banquet, a subsidy of NT\$80,000-NT\$120,000 is provided for a cultural performance based on the total number of travelers.  The subsidies are designed to be used to pay expense related to welcome banners for the tour group, cultural performances, artistic programs with special Taiwanese characteristics, or visits to local sites of historic or cultural significance, accommodation, meals, entrance tickets, rental of activity venues, and reception by domestic travel operators.  <b>Application deadline:</b> At least 15 days before the foreign person is to arrive in Taiwan for the on-site survey.

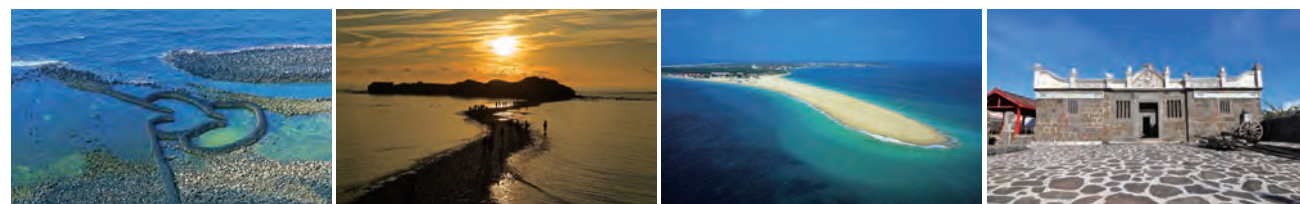

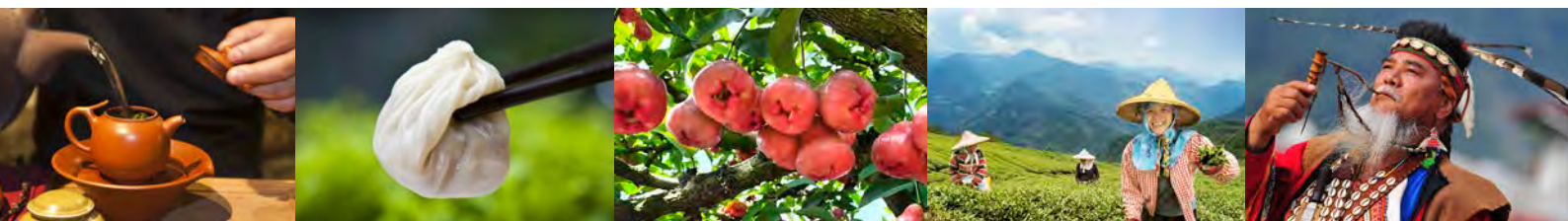
