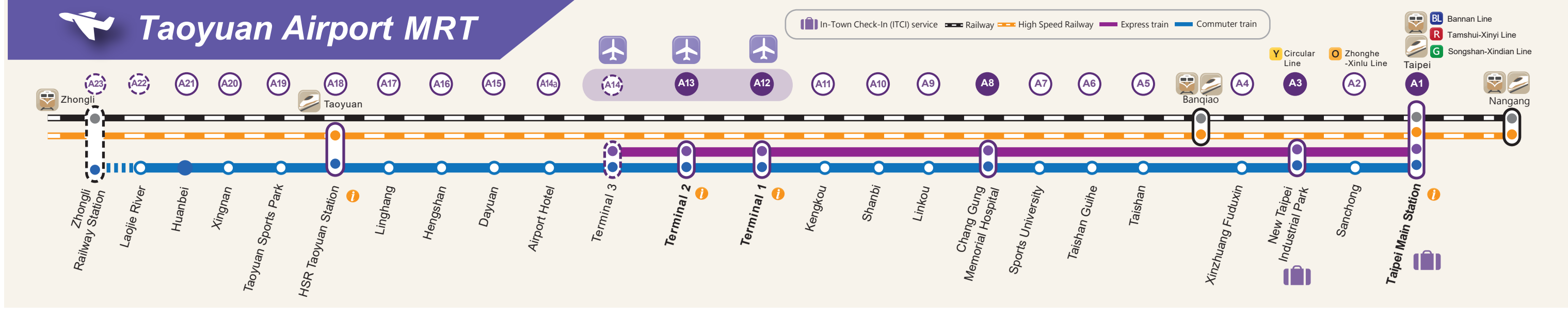

Connections From the Airports

From Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport
Taoyuan Airport MRT: Both Express and Commuter train stop at Terminal 1 (A12) and Terminal 2 (A13), with trains arriving about every 7.5 minutes, alternating between the two types. The Express train takes about 35-40 minutes to travel from Taoyuan Airport to Taipei Main Station. The Commuter train takes about 60 minutes.

Taiwan High Speed Rail (HSR) MRT trains to Taoyuan HSR Station are available at both Terminals 1 and 2.

Passenger Buses: Taxicabs can travel directly to Taipei, Taichung, Keelung, Taoyuan, Zhongli, Taichung and Hsinchu by passenger buses, which are available at both Terminals 1 and 2.

Terminal 1 bus stop: B1 bus area of Arrival Hall.

Terminal 2 bus stop: north side of Arrival Hall on the first floor.

*Please inquire on bus fares and ticket purchases at the Passenger Bus Ticket Counter. Taxi 24-hour services are available at both Terminals 1 and 2. Service is provided to all areas of Taiwan. Reasonable standard fares apply depending on destination.

From Taipei Songshan Airport
This airport is situated in the Taipei urban area, providing convenient transportation. A Taipei Metro station and city buses are located near the departure hall. Taxi charge standard fares according to taxi meters.

From Keelung Ching Chuan Kang Airport
Tourists can take the city bus to Taichung Railway Station and Taichung High Speed Rail Station to connect to other metropolitan areas. Fares vary depending on distances. For more information about round trips to Sun Moon Lake and High Speed Rail stations, please visit www.tca.gov.tw.

From Kaohsiung International Airport
In the airport terminal, tourists can take the Red Line Kaohsiung Mass Rapid Transit to Kaohsiung Railway Station (Main Station) or to the High Speed Rail Taichung Station and travel to other cities. Bus and taxi services are available; please visit the official website for more information.

Traveler's Cheques and Credit Cards
Please exchange your traveler's cheques for cash in advance. Traveler's cheques are not accepted in most shops in Taiwan, whereas credit cards are rather popular. Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB, China UnionPay, Diners Clubs International are well-accepted. If you travel to the Taiwan countryside, make sure you prepare enough cash in case credit cards are not available.

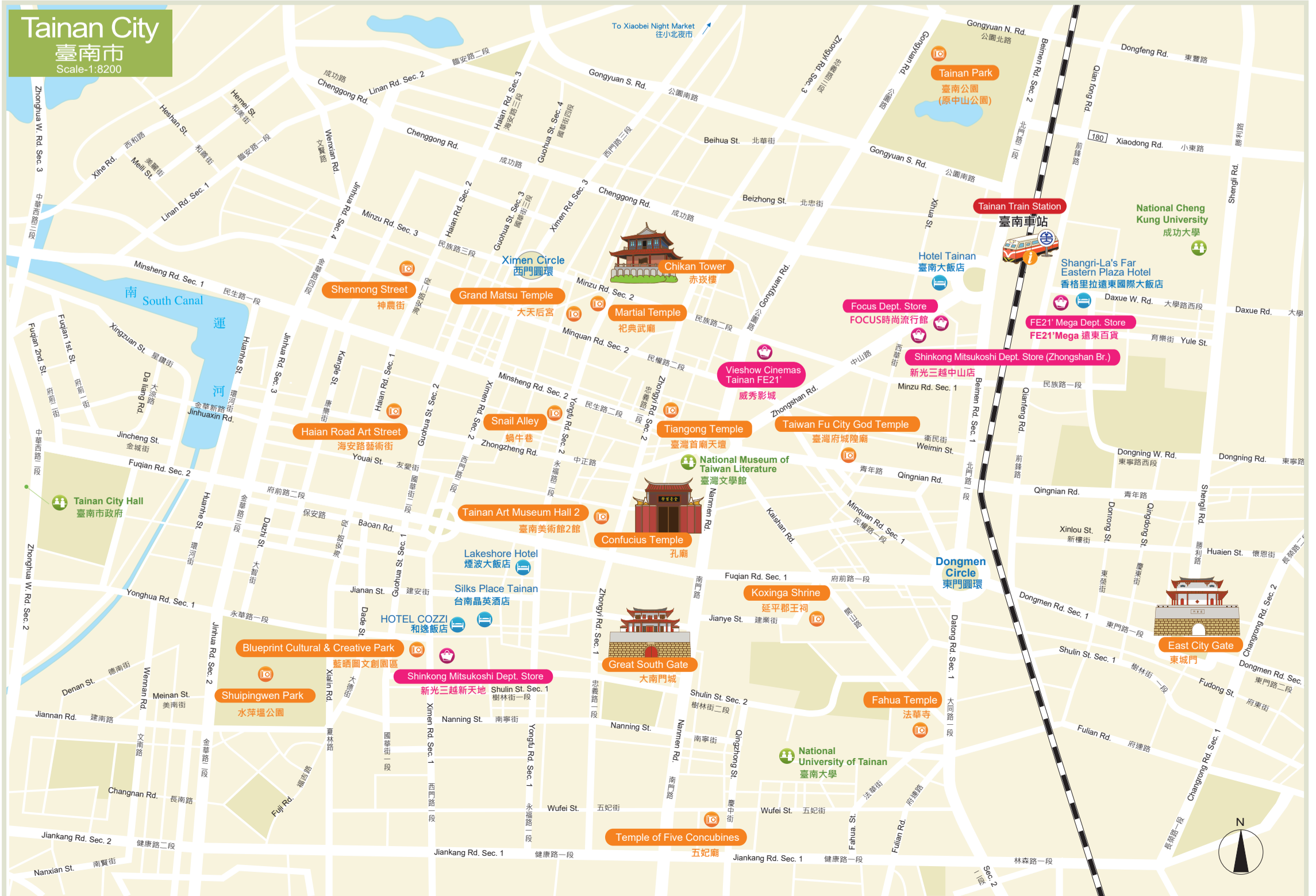
Voltage and Power Sockets
Taiwan uses 110V or 220V electric current, and the frequency is 60Hz. Please note your electronic appliances specifications if brought from abroad. The common power socket type is A, therefore a power converter is suggested.

Taxes and Tax Refunds
Commodity tax is usually included in the bill for purchases, or additional fees are charged. Standard receipts will be given after purchases.

If you wish to claim your tax refund, please stop at authorized Tax Refund Stores (TRS). With purchases totaling NT\$2,000 or more in one store or on one day, you can receive tax refunds at airports or customs stations within 30 days of making the purchase or before you go through customs in the airports departure hall.

Service Charges
Most hotels and upscale restaurants will charge a 10% service charge.

Wireless Network
Free wireless access is available in the airport and train stations, MRT stations, tourist information centers, and also other public spaces in Taiwan.



MAP OF TAIWAN

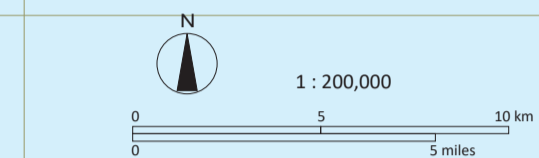
