

# A Romantic Stroll Through Hakka Villages

Heartwarming Encounters in the Hills

From the deep indigo of traditional dyes to the soothing aroma of ground tea, the Hakka communities nestled in the hills of Hsinchu and Miaoli have long woven quiet beauty into the everyday life of Taiwan.

Begin your journey on historic Beipu Old Street, where you can visit Chiang A-Hsin Mansion, the setting of the acclaimed drama Gold Leaf. Then, taste the flavors of memory: a bowl of Muslim-friendly lei cha, a mugwort steamed buns, and a snow-white slice of dried persim-

To the south, visit Twin Peaks Tea House, where a bite of handmade dorayaki and a sip of honey black tea make the forest landscapes even sweeter. At Tongluo Tea Factory and Hobbit Valley, you'll find a peaceful tea farm and a whimsical world of fantasy. In Zhuolan, the hydrangeas at Flower Home bloom like drifting clouds, while LoFi Land invites you to walk barefoot through the soil and feel the poetry of farm life. This thoughtful journey through Taiwan's Hakka heartland offers a taste of the island's most sincere and generous spirit.

#### Taiwan's Largest Hydrangea Garden

Located in the rolling hills of Zhuolan, Flower Home is Taiwan's largest flower farm, spanning 8 acres. From March to June, the landscape bursts into color as hydrangeas paint the fields in vibrant shades, drawing visitors from all over to witness their spectacular display. The farm also features Taiwan's first Essential Oil Museum, where rooms filled with fragrant blossoms invite you to lose yourself in this enchanting scents. Recent additions include the country's only hydrangea-themed mini train and a hydrangea carousel. Special hydrangea ice cream cones are available for you to enjoy while strolling through the farm's romantic scenes.

# A Dessert Hideaway in the Woods



Beipu Old Street has the highest concentration of historic landmarks among all of Taiwan's heritage streets. Within just 200 meters, there are seven significant historical buildings, including the Jin Guang Fu Hall and the Chiang Family Tianshui Hall. Chiang A-Hsin Mansion, a highlight of the old street, features a striking blend of European and Hakka design and served as a filming location for the acclaimed TV drama Gold Leaf. The mansion preserves a wealth of period artifacts, making it a must-see for history lovers.

# The Beauty of Hakka Stone-Ground Tea

#### Handmade Lei Cha

A Chinese Muslim Association certified Muslim-friendly restaurant, Puyu Hakka Leicha serves authentic Hakka-style ground tea, perfect for sharing. This traditional dish begins with a green tea base, blended with roasted sesame seeds, peanuts, pumpkin seeds, and a variety of grains. Using a wooden pestle and ceramic bowl, the ingredients are ground into a fine powder, then mixed with hot water to create a rich, smooth, and aromatic brew. A sprinkle of crispy puffed rice on top adds the final touch to the satisfying and nourish-

#### **Dried Persimmons**

Skilled in the art of preservation, Hakka communities dry persimmons into chewy, sun-dried cakes, a hallmark of Hakka culinary tradition. Located on Beipu Old Street, Jiang Taigong Persimmons is a time-honored shop selling dried persimmons of its own production, including stone persimmons, oxheart persimmons, and pencil persimmons. As they dry under the sun, a delicate layer of natural sugar forms on their orange-red skin, creating "persimmon frost," a sweet, snowy bloom that's as beautiful as it is flavorful.









#### **Innovative Hakka Rice Cakes**

Ban(粄)—rice-based cakes—are a traditional delicacy not to be missed when visiting Hakka villages. At Tsu Chi Rice Cake, visitors can enjoy a modern, vegetarian version that's certified Muslim-friendly. The dough is infused with mugwort, a fragrant Taiwanese herb, giving the cakes a natural green color. Fillings range from savory shredded radish to sweet red bean and taro paste, offering a delightful balance of coming back for more.

Begin in old town on Taiwan Connection 1908, Taichung's "greenway" built along the former railway line. You'll encounter local landmarks, like Miyahara and the Fourth Credit Unionhistoric structures transformed into charming dessert parlors.

Buildings designed by world-class architects await in the modern districts. Visit the National Taichung Theater and CMP Inspiration and with every step, you'll dance in harmony with sweeping curves and bold lines, a reimagination of what "space" can be. These are not just photo spots—they are design and culture in perfect balance.

For a taste of the unexpected, try a Michelin-rated creation at MINIMAL, where ice cream is taken to its creative limit. Or visit the Taiwan Agro-Fisheries Market and bring home flavors of Taichung's fertile land and rich waters.

#### A Railway Transformed into Taiwan's Only Elevated Greenway

Taiwan Connection 1908 is Taiwan's only elevated greenway and links Taichung's past and present. Spanning about 1.6 kilometers, it preserves the 1908 railway and offers views of the Lyuchuan Canal and buildings including Miyahara. The new Tielu Avenue shopping complex, train car cafés and cultural-creative shops give the greenway an artistic flair and maintain its living history.

Built in 1966 as the Taichung Fourth Credit Union Headquarters, this former bank retains its original reinforced concrete façade, vault door, and terrazzo flooring. These vintage features are paired with crystal chandeliers and an old service counter, creating a unique

industrial-meets-retro style. The menu offers over 50 flavors of ice cream,

shaved ice, waffles, and brunch plates. Frozen treats can be paired with cheesecake or local pineapple cakes, perfect for a relaxing afternoon tea.

# An Architectural Masterpiece by Kengo Kuma

The first museum in Taiwan designed by renowned Japanese architect Kengo Kuma, "lifting the earth" is the central concept to the design of CMP Inspiration. Built as a sunken landscape structure, its 410-ping (1,355 m²) curved form and green rooftop blend seamlessly with the surrounding urban greenery. Since opening, it has become one of the most striking structures on the Taichung Greenway. Visitors can wander through airy corridors, spiral staircases, and open courtyards, admiring exhibitions in a space that heightens the impact of each artistic encounter.

#### An IFLA Library to See Before You Die

Designed by JJP Architects & Planners, the National Library of Public Information draws inspiration from the Möbius strip. Its white mosaic façade echoes the flowing shapes of Taichung's riverscape, earning it the title of "Taichung's Most Beautiful Public Library" and a place on the IFLA list of "1001 Libraries to Visit Before You Die." As the largest library in central Taiwan, it holds over 1.64 million volumes and offers e-books, AR experiences, and even robot-assisted services—blending knowledge, design, and technology into one.

Chef Arvin Wan approaches gelato with the mindset of modern cuisine, treating it as a medium for culinary creativity. Using precise temperature control and incorporating local Taiwanese ingredients such as angelica, camellia oil, and Taiwanese teas, he crafts changing menus of distinctive flavors, boldly reimagining traditional frozen desserts. In 2024, MINIMAL was awarded one Michelin star, making it the first gelato house in the world to receive this honor.


#### Discover a New Perspective in the World of Two Wheels

Nestled at the foot of Alishan, the Japanese period logging industry caused Chiayi to flourish, earning it the nickname "Wood City." Shaped by its forestry heritage, Chiayi has unique historic homes and a tradition of fine craftsmanship.

Begin at Beimen Station, a century-old railway stop, and explore Hinoki Village, the Chiayi Sawmill, and the Railway Garage Park, where traces of the city's old industry remain vivid, each stop another page in Chiayi's story. In the market district, a century-old police station has been transformed into a literature museum. Or visit the art museum housed in the former Public Monopoly Bureau Building near the train station.

These spaces, blending old and new, spark creativity, filling the city with stylish boutiques and inviting cafés. In Chiayi, travel isn't just sightseeing, it's an immersive cultural experience.

Once an important refueling stop on the Alishan Forest Railway, Fengihu Station served as a key midway point where steam trains paused to take on water and coal before climbing deeper into the mountains. Next to the station stands the historic 1912 Loco Shed, now a Chiayi County-designated heritage site. Inside, vintage locomotives, tools, and hinoki-wood train cars bring to life the stories of rail workers and mountain routes. The old depot has been transformed into a cozy café and ice cream shop. 

# **Central Taiwan's Festival Calendar**


